# How come sometimes when I create an event in OGM it gets approved automatically when other times what I would consider less risky events get reviewed and approved by a person?

This is because if it is a camp and you have listed a camp qualified person it will automatically approve as if you have the camp certificate it is presumed you know what you are doing. For anything else it should go through to a person to approve.

# Would you welcome RIL's into the working groups for the National Operating Plan as mentioned in the meeting tonight?

No, as we will be covering some safeguarding topics but there will be opportunities for them in the future.

#### What would be the time commitment for the working groups, and can you be on more than one?
