

## HOW DO I MAKE A GIFT?

Your Will is a legal document, so we strongly advise that you seek professional assistance from a solicitor or trustee company to ensure that your wishes are clearly and correctly recorded.

After you have considered the gifts you wish to make to family and friends, there are several ways you can also leave a gift in your Will to GirlGuiding New Zealand:

- a percentage of your estate (called a 'Contingency Bequest')
- a specific sum of money (a 'Pecuniary Bequest')
- a particular item such as property or jewellery (a 'Specific Bequest')
- the remainder of your estate after leaving specific gifts to family and other beneficiaries (a 'Residuary Bequest')

If you would like to leave a gift to GirlGuiding New Zealand in your Will, we would encourage you to contact us to talk about how that gift might have the most impact.

Your lawyer will then be able to set up or amend your Will, advise you on the type of gift that will suit you and your estate, and assist you with appropriate wording.
